If you are an existing Christian Center Elementary or Daycare family, you may insure your child has a spot in the elementary or preschool by registering by January 22.

LATE TUITION PAYMENTS: Tuition is due the first of the month and becomes overdue after the 15th. A late fee of \$20.00 is added to overdue accounts.

If, for any reason you are unable to meet your tuition obligation, you must contact the school without delay. If your tuition becomes more than 60 days overdue, your child may be denied class attendance. Overdue accounts may be turned over to a collection agency. Accounts must be paid in full before final report cards are released.
